ONLINE PAYMENT FACILITY

Towards the end of this academic year your child will bring home a letter about our new online payment facility PARENTPAY. In an attempt to remove all cash and cheques from school we are asking that parents use this online payment method for things such as dinner money trips as of 7th September 2016. All children will be given a unique account number and password in order to do this. When you receive your letter you can activate your child's account immediately ready for use in September. Can we please ask that your child's current lunch account is up to date at the end of this summer term (Friday 22nd July) so that this one can be deactivated. Any outstanding balances will be transferred to their ParentPay account (or to their new school in the case of year six pupils) at the end of term. Any credit remaining on a child's account can either be refunded or transferred at the end of term. If you do not have access to the internet or wish to pay cash then please contact Emma/Helen in the office to request the option of paying via PayPoint. We appreciate that it is going to take some time for parents (and us!!) to get used to a new, online payment system but we are hoping that, in time, we will all find it an easier and more efficient way of working.
