<u>Lunches</u>

Please note that if your child has just moved upstairs into year 3, they now need to pay for school lunches. The cost of a school meal is £2.30 per day and can be paid via ParentPay.

Could we remind all parents with children who have packed lunches to include a drink to be taken with their lunch and food that is healthy, no sweets, nuts or fizzy drinks.

Parent Pay

As you are aware this is a changing world and Fishergate Primary should be a cash free office. This entails all future payments for any services (Dinners, School trips, swimming, clubs etc) provided by School should be paid via Parent Pay, our online finance system for parents. For future charity events we will collect the cash in the classrooms as we have always done previously.
