What has FoF fundraising helped with this year?

Subsidised the Summer trips for all year groups; Science Day; extra books for classrooms; coach for the Y5/6 Robin Wood Outdoor Pursuits trip; Y6 Leavers' Treat at Tenpin; equipment for Y3/4 swimming classes; costumes for Y1/2 nativity; subsidised the pantomime trip for all year groups; subsidised the Young Voices trip for KS2 choir; bought medals for Star Wars Marathon; a greenhouse for the Forest School area; BBC Microbit coding boards. We're talking to the school about what major project FoF might help with next year (in the past, FoF has bought the playframe in the playground and new Chrome books, for example).
