I would like to make you aware that the Department for Education has recently laid out the new challenge for school attendance by raising the level at which a child is deemed persistently absent from school. Persistent absence data will now include all pupils whose attendance is 90% or less as opposed to 85% previously. This change will inevitably make it easier for children to fall into this category and I would therefore like to ask you to ensure that all children are in school every day unless the reason for absence is unavoidable.
