## Helping with Special Educational Needs & Disabilities in Primary School



This course aims to build on the knowledge gained on the WEA Volunteers Helping in Schools course or equivalent courses. It will look at provision in mainstream for children with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) and the implications of making this provision. It aims to develop student self-confidence, increase communication skills (both oral and written) and equip students to effectively and professionally support pupils with a wide range of needs. Accreditation can be achieved dependent on satisfactory achievement of all the set Learning Outcomes for the course. Admission to the course is strictly limited to those who are able to volunteer in school 2 hours per week.

## This is a CERTA (formally OCNYHR) Accredited Course developed by the WEA and will include:

- A brief history of Special Educational Needs
- Current legislation and definitions
- Current framework for provision for pupils with SEND
- Roles and responsibilities of Local Authorities and Schools
- Inclusion
- Administration and target setting
- Information on the range of SEND in mainstream and special schools
- Supporting pupils with SEND in mainstream
- Practical activities and games for supporting pupils with a range of difficulties
- Supporting children with Communication and Interaction needs, including Autism
- Supporting children with Specific Learning Difficulties
- Supporting children with Physical and Sensory needs
- Supporting children with Behaviour, Emotional and Social needs
