



## Year 6 Trip to Crucial Crew

Dear Parents/Carers,

Your child is invited to attend Crucial Crew on Tuesday 10th July. Crucial Crew is vital to encourage good citizenship and reduce accidents, injury, and crime and protect young people through education and awareness. The event is designed to educate 'Year 6' pupils in North Yorkshire to make informed decisions when faced with danger and respond effectively to emergency situations and accidents. Each workshop promotes an awareness of crime and crime prevention issues relevant to the communities in which the students live. The event also encourages active participation by all 'Year 6' students and shows synchronicity between the Crucial Crew event and the schools citizenship curriculum/PSHE.

Students will rotate around ten, 10 minute scenarios to be staffed by North Yorkshire Police, , North Yorkshire Fire & Rescue, Powergrid Electricity, IDAS Domestic Abuse Service, NYCC Road Safety, Northern Gas, Network rail, NYCC Community Cohesion covering respect and identity, Farm Safety Volunteers will staff a switchboard to receive '999' calls from the children. Subjects to be covered include Fire Safety, Water Safety, Road Safety, Internet Safety, Electricity Safety, Gas safety, Alcohol and Anti-Social Behaviour, stress and anxiety in young persons, Theft/Consequences of Crime, First Aid and how and when to make 999 calls in emergencies.

We will travel by coach in the morning, returning to school for a slightly late lunch. Could you return the form below to the class teacher and use Parent Pay to pay £4.50.
