PHASE 2

- **Set 1**: s, a, t, p
- **Set 2**: i, n, m, d
- **Set 3**: g, o, c, k
- **Set 4**: ck, e, u, r
- **Set 5**: h, b, f, ff, I, II, ss

PHASE 3

- **oSet 6:** j, v, w, x
- **Set 7**: y, z, zz, qu
- Digraphs & trigraphs: ch, sh, th, ng, ai, ee, igh, oa, oo, ar, or, ur, ow, oi, ear, air, ure, er

PHASE 4

This phase consolidates all the children have learnt in the previous phases.




