

Behaviour at Fishergate School



All children can expect the following from adults at Fishergate School:

Treat others with kindness, calmness and consistency

Care about the whole family

Give children space and time to talk about the feelings which drive their behaviour

Support children to move around all areas of school calmly

Our 3 Rules:

Ready

Respect

Safe

Over and Above behaviours to strive for:

Being consistently hardworking

Being a kind, supportive friend to others every day

Restorative questions:

What happened?

How were you feeling at the time?

How do you feel now?

What could we do to put things right?

Consequences:

- 1. Reminder**
- 2. 5 minutes with an adult at break (This can be earned back)**
- 3. 10 minutes with an adult at break**
- 4. Serious behaviours lead to a conversation with Mrs Clarke; parents/carers contacted and a fitting consequence decided**

Possible microscripts:

You need to complete three more questions. I know you can work really well because you did a fantastic piece of work in I want to see that attitude now and I know you can do it.

I can see you're upset. I want to help. When you're ready, tell me about it and I'll listen. Let's go over here...
