You don't need me to tell you how much learning is lost. Generally in school, the children with the poorest attendance have some of the lowest attainment. As many of our interventions run at the beginning of the school day children who are routinely late will also miss this valuable support. If you want to give your child the best future possible you must get them into school.
