**EYU** - This week in Early Years, the little ones have become chefs. We have been planning and making healthy snacks in the shape of hungry caterpillars. **Year 1/2** - in Literacy, Key Stage 1 have been continuing to write their own stories based on 'Katie and the Sunflowers', whilst in Maths Year 1 have been learning to tell the time to the quarter hour and Year 2 to five minute intervals.
