PHASE UPDATES

EYU – This week we have continued our study of all things autumn. We have read Leaf Man and have been busy creating and drawing leaf people. In Phonics our new sounds have been ck, e, u, r. Our number of the week has been 3. We loved finding small creatures in the forest, we found slugs under logs keeping their slug eggs safe.

Year 1/2 - KS1 have been learning 'Room on the Broom' as part of their Talk4Writing project and will be starting to innovate their own 'Room on the Broom' stories as part of 'Spooky Week' next week.

Year 3/4 – Yr 3/4 have been working on a very modelled story based around the Iron Man but with a different hero, a dragon and an erupting volcano. Who will help save the day? Every day, the teacher speaks aloud as they model writing the next part of the class story, sharing their thoughts on the structure of their writing and the use of vocabulary. Then we allow the children to write a little more independently each day as the week progresses. Why not ask your child about the story gist.

Y5/6 - Friday's Viking battle was a huge success! A thank you to our parents for helping their children to look the part. In English, we are exploring Norse myths and in Maths we are coming to the end of our decimals topic.
