We had some lovely feedback from PAWS, following Rach's first visit last week. These are some of the highlights:

"Rach had the loveliest introduction to Bodhi—he was resting peacefully as you approached, then greeted us gently with his tail wagging and all four paws on the floor. His calm, soft greeting and ability to regulate his excitement so beautifully were a joy to observe and a credit to the secure foundation you've already built with him. Bodhi is clearly relaxed in the building, which is remarkable given his young age and early stage of training. His morning classroom visits are not only manageable for him but have already had a lovely impact on staff wellbeing. As Bodhi is still a puppy and just at the beginning of his therapy dog journey, you're right to be thinking proactively about how best to support him. One emerging theme is that, while he's very relaxed inside the school, the outside environment (sights, smells and sounds) can be overwhelming for him. We've therefore chosen to dial back some of his adult interactions to better protect his rest, and to start gently building his resilience outdoors. It was such a privilege for Rach to work with you all—you're an exceptional team, and the care, thought and humour you bring to this journey made the session truly enjoyable. Bodhi is in the safest of hands, and we're genuinely excited to see how his confidence and skills evolve over the coming months."
