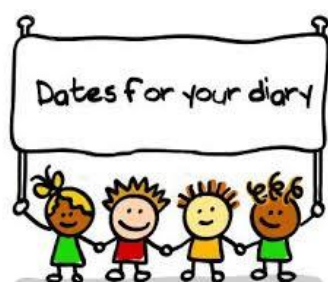

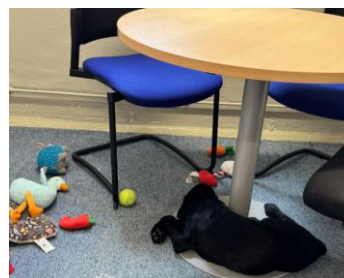
ART CLUB
